
1&1 suggests the use of <u>IMAP</u> over <u>POP3</u>.

Under Server, enter imap.1and1.co.uk and enter 993 in the Port text box. Choose SSL/TLS as the Security type. Click on Next when finished.



Enter auth.smtp.1and1.co.uk in the SMTP server text box and 587 in the Port text box. Check the box for Require signin.

Enter your **full E-mail address** and your **E-mail address password**. Click on **Next** to proceed.



Account name and your name


Step 7
