Set Up E-mail on an iPhone

For iOS 9.1

Before you begin, you will need to Create 1&1 Mail Basic Account.


Step 1

Find and click **Settings** on your iDevice.



iPhone home screen


Scroll down and select **Mail, Contacts, Calendars**.


Step 3

Mail, Contacts, Calendars screen


Scroll down and select Other.

Select Add Mail Account.

Step 6

Enter the **Name** you wish to display to others when sending an E-mail, your **full E-mail Address** and the **Password** for the E-mail account. The description will mirror the E-mail Address by default,



although you may change it. New account screen

Step 7

Tap the **Next** button.

Ensure that **IMAP** is selected at the top and that the name, address and description have been carried over.

Scroll down and enter **imap.1and1.co.uk** in the Host Name field and your **full E-mail Address** in the User Name field under the Incoming Mail Server section.


Enter auth.smtp.1and1.co.uk without the quotes in the Host Name field and your full E-mail address in the User Name field under the Outgoing Mail Server section. Enter the Password for the E-mail account.

Step 10


Tap the **Next** button.


Step 11

Turn Mail syncing **ON**. Optionally, you may also turn on Notes syncing.
